


# Kansai's Advantages for Foreign Companies

Kansai becomes one of the most attractive places as to its economic fundamentals, therefore a number of foreign companies has already set up operations in Kansai region.







# Current Trade Scale in Kansai




Electric appliances and machinery account for more than a half of the total export value, and Asia is the major export counterpart.

# Value of Exports by Commodity (Japan)











Reflecting the concentration of the manufacturing industry, mineral fuels and electric appliances constitute a significant share. Import from Asia including China accounts for more than a half.

## Value of Imports by Commodity (Kansai)






### Value of Imports by Commodity (Japan)






